Paintball Vandals Caught

On November 12th at 8:03pm, police responded to a property damage call on Monticello Dr., where the home had been hit by an orange paintball. While answering this call, the police received a second call on a home on Fallbrook Dr. that had been hit by a paintball. The police responded and the homeowner was able to block the two suspects from leaving the scene and stopped them at Elizabeth Lee Dr. and

Jameson Dr. They were driving a silver 2001 Nissan Pathfinder. One of the two occupants (the driver) gave a written statement to the police that he and the other passenger had shot at numerous houses in The Woodlands, Laurel Park, and Sheffield Manor in the last two months. The other occupant would not talk. On the passenger floorboard were a slingshot and a box of orange paintballs along with steel shot. The suspects were consequently arrested. Thanks go out to the neighbors for calling the Concord Police Department non-emergency phone number to report these incidents, as this information led to these arrests.

Do You Need to Recycle Dead Batteries or Used Motor Oil?

The Household Hazardous Waste Facility is open Monday-Friday from 8am to 5pm and accepts the following:

- used motor oil, oil bottles, & oil filters,
- batteries of any type,
- used anti-freeze, all grades of scrap metal (call about drums, tanks, power equipment, etc.),
- white goods (fridge, washer/dryer, stove, microwave, air conditioner, water heater, etc.). These items can also be picked up curbside by the city by calling 704-920-5555,

- empty inkjet and toner cartridges,
- and photographic film and disposable cameras.

On the first Wednesday (8am-4pm) and 3rd Saturday (8am-1pm) of the month, the facility will accept electronics such as computers, TVs, and cell phones. Call first to confirm item acceptability and safe transportation.

- From January to July every year, North Carolinians throw away enough trash to build a three by three foot wall around the earth.
- Newspaper and corrugated cardboard are the highest recycled types of paper—in North Carolina, we recycle 57% of all newspaper and 50% of all cardboard.
- Glass bottles can be used hundreds of times over to make new bottles. North Carolina has three glass plants capable of consuming

thousands of tons of "cullet" or recovered glass.

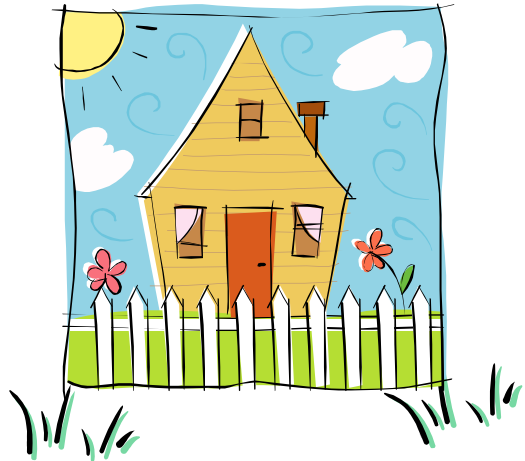
